

What is an essay and what they eat it with?

After receiving an essay assignment, students are very upset when they think that they will have to write something. In fact, there is nothing wrong with writing an essay, because by the rules it is written in free form and has no serious requirements for structure, and if you have a little money you can always ask professionals to «write my essay for me cheap» and get a great result for a reasonable fee.

An essay is a work of small volume, the composition of which depends only on the author.

If you pay attention to the stylistics of an essay by different authors, some works are read in one breath, while others are boring and uninteresting. Of course, each of us has a different technique of writing, and not all have literary talent, but much depends on the author's attitude to the topic of the work. It depends on how enthusiastically the student will approach the creative process, namely, how you can call writing an essay, depends on how brightly the topic will be revealed. The originality of the work is also influenced by the fact what kind and form of essay will be chosen.

Since an essay does not have a strict form, there is no clear classification of types, so there are several options.

The smallest classification is represented by two points: subjective and objective views. The task of the first one is to reveal the identity of the author, and the second one - the idea or subject of the description.

Based on the content, distinguish spiritual and religious, historical, literary and critical, philosophical, artistic or artistic and journalistic kinds of essays.

If we talk about the literary form, such types of essays as notes, lyrical miniatures, letters, reviews, diary are distinguished.

Making an accent on composition, there are analytical, critical, descriptive, narrative and reflexive kinds of essays.

There are other types: character analysis, literary analysis, argumentation, descriptive, defining, causal and comparative essays.

As you can see, it is better to choose the most convenient and appropriate type for writing the work. Thus, for example, if we focus on a comparative essay, we will have to focus on similarities and differences, both between people and between ideas or subjects; if it is argumentative, we will have to present and prove assumptions; if it is descriptive, we will have to convey the main characteristics of the object, whether it is its appearance, smell, texture, etc. If you need to write a literary essay, it is logical to choose between a literary critical essay, a review, a literary analysis, or an analysis of character. Again, if a person likes to reflect, you can choose a philosophical essay, if you want to make an essay more frank - choose the type of letter, diary or note, give preference to a role-playing essay in order to put yourself in someone's place or describe the reaction to a certain situation.

Whatever the classification of an essay, it is important to choose the most appropriate and appropriate form to reflect the topic of the essay, then the content will be fine. The most important thing is to express a point of view on the problem in the clearest possible way, and a properly chosen type of essay will only contribute to this goal.
